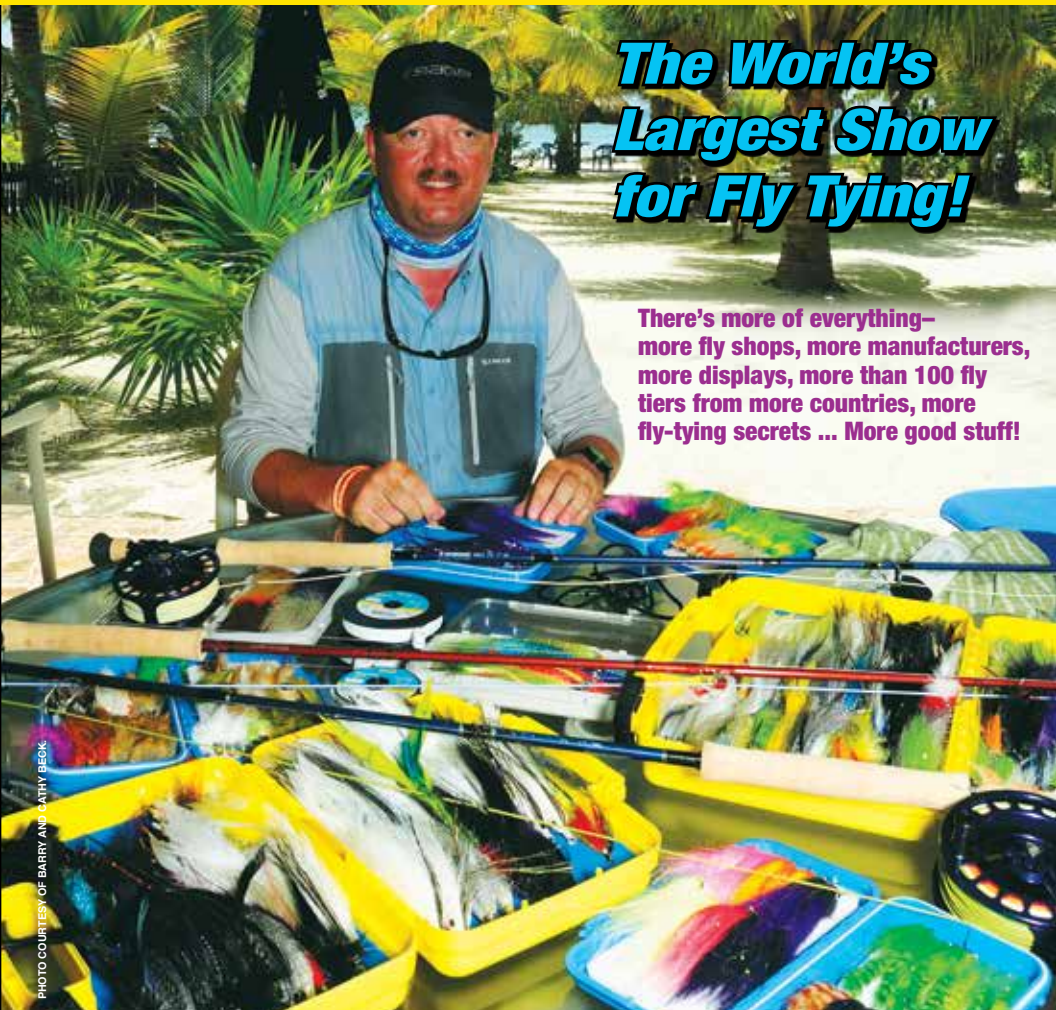

## CASTING CLASS

### Sunday 8:30-11:00

**Note:** This class takes place at the Garden State Exhibit Center where the symposium is held. So don't register at the DoubleTree Hotel, go right to the show lobby by 8:15.

**Note:** Most classes require some tying experience and others may require more. Ask us when you call. Beginners are welcome, but be prepared for more than basics. All students must bring their own tying vise, tools, lamp if needed, and a sampling of materials. Most classes will provide adequate materials for the patterns being taught. If a class is cancelled, you will be notified 5 days prior to the weekend and either permitted to switch or receive an authorized refund.

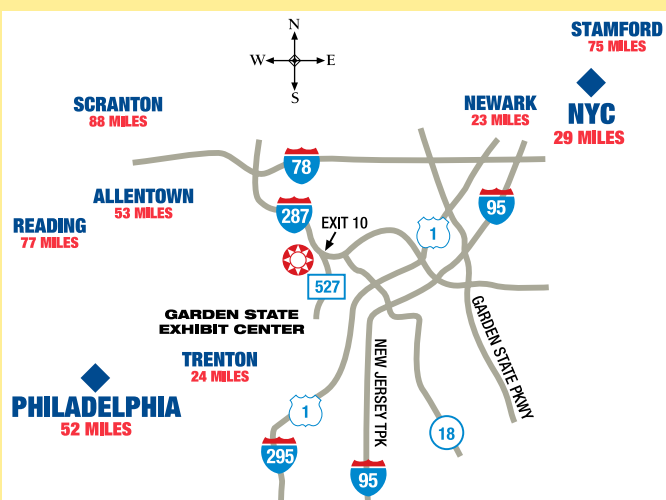
## DIRECTIONS
